Tuberculosis Test

The applicant as identified below has applied to the Five Branches University Master of Traditional Chinese Medicine program. The course of study at Five Branches University includes clinical training. In order to ensure that safety precautions are maintained in the Five Branches clinic and to maintain a healthy environment on campus we require the applicant to have a Tuberculosis test prior to enrollment in the program.

Evidence of a current tuberculosis test must be submitted no later than 10 days prior to admission. Candidate students with a previous or current positive tuberculosis skin test must submit a written report of a negative chest X-ray, taken six months prior to initial attendance. A positive chest X-ray requires physician demonstration of non-infection, prior to enrollment. In such cases, chest X-rays must be taken every five years while tuberculosis tests are to be taken annually. All medical records will be kept confidential and will not be released without the signed consent of the student.
